### Spring Open Burn Season

The Spring Burn season is from March 30<sup>th</sup> to May 30<sup>th</sup>. Open Burning is regulated by the Division of Air Quality (DAQ). Please follow the below steps to obtain your permits.

- Complete Burn application by calling (801) 536-4000, or online at <http://www.airquality.utah.gov/Compliance/OpenBurning/index.htm>
- Once Application is submitted please come to Wellington City Hall to receive your Burn Permit. Wellington City will not be able to issue permits until the state process is completed.
