**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER ASSISTANCE TO
REPLACE 100-WATT SODIUM VAPOR LIGHTS WITH 50-WATT LED LIGHTS**

WHEREAS, the public interest will be best served by these lights being replaced and making Wellington City become energy efficient and environmentally friendly

WHEREAS, to keep costs minimal the sodium vapor lights will be replaced as they fail with LED lights.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that this Resolution be sent to Rocky Mountain Power requesting their assistance in these changes.

- Rocky Mountain Power will send a contract of work to Wellington City for each light to be replaced.

Motion for the adoption of this resolution was made by Council member Tatton and seconded by Council member Willson and motion carried by a vote as follows:


