

PUBLIC NOTICE

In this difficult time I thought it best to issue this DIRECTIVE. This DIRECTIVE supplements the statement issued on March 18, 2020 and is submitted due to the DIRECTIVE issued by Governor Herbert last Friday, March 27, 2020.

First, from Wellington City, thank you for your patience and concern. Our priority is to our employees and their families, the citizens of Wellington City and the State of Utah. Our thoughts and prayers are with you all. With this in mind, I issue this DIRECTIVE.

Wellington City supports Governor Herbert's DIRECTIVE issued March 27, 2020. I want to emphasize the need to minimize physical contact. Please take a moment and review the Governor's DIRECTIVE TO THE STATE OF UTAH. Please pay particular attention to that portion of the Governor's DIRECTIVE as it addresses INDIVIDUALS and ORGANIZATIONS.

From that DIRECTIVE, I want to emphasize the following points.

INDIVIDUALS:

- Stay at home as much as possible.
- Utilize appropriate social distancing including:
 - a. Maintain a 6 foot distance.
 - b. Not shaking hands.
 - c. Do not congregate.
- Self quarantine for 14 days after traveling or being exposed.

ORGANIZATIONS:

- Enhance social distancing by having limited contact with coemployees and others in the workplace.
- Enable employees and volunteers to follow personal care directives.
- Minimize face-to-face contact.
- Implement flexible work hours.

I have instructed Wellington City employees to work remotely as best they can. We are continuing to provide services to our citizens. We ask individuals to accomplish as much as they can remotely either by telephone or on the Internet. Our website is always available at www.wellingtonutah.us. The Wellington city office will be closed and not available to walk-in customers.
